Article 1

The historic Association "Commemoration of the Grand Prix de Tours", Association law of 1901 N°037201047 affiliated to the French Federation of Vintage Vehicles (FFVE) under N° 1125 will organise on 24th.June 2023

- A Historic Touristic rally, without fixed times or imposed averages, called: THE COMMEMORATION OF THE CENTENARY OF THE GRAND PRIX DE TOURS reserved for vintage and classic cars from 1900 to 1993 (over 30 years old)
- CHINON CLASSIC, A PRESENTATION OF VINTAGE AND CLASSIC CARS AND MOTORCYCLES ON CLOSED ROADS IN CHINON

The Rally complies with the general provisions of the International Federation of Old Vehicles (F.I.V.A.). **It is in no way a sporting event.**

Its purpose is to allow collectors of vintage and classic vehicles to drive their vehicles in optimal safety conditions and to highlight, by showcasing and bringing to life the industrial heritage that these vehicles constitute. It also promotes the discovery of the landscape, architectural, cultural and historical heritage of our regions.

The Rally is organised so that each participant, whatever the age and the capacity of his vehicle, can complete the route in good safety conditions.

It takes place on the open road, in compliance with the Highway Code, with the aim of not disturbing the traffic of other road users or the tranquility of local residents and will not give rise to any classification based on navigation and/or regularity.

The departure of participants is staggered so as not to interfere with road traffic.

Article 2 Cars Eligible for the Event

All classic cars in perfect working order, whose characteristics conform to the original, over 30 years old (unless exceptional exemption granted by the organisers). The rally is also open to "SUPERCAR" cars less than 30 years old. The Grand Prix de Tours association reserves the right to refuse any vehicle that does not comply with the spirit of the event.

Any change of vehicle must be immediately reported to the organisers who reserve the right to accept or refuse the said vehicle.

Article 3 Obligations

Participants must comply with the requirements of the Highway Code, municipal and prefectural laws, as well as the articles of these rules. In addition, they must respect the signaling that may be made by the officials.

**The visible rally plate is compulsory on the vehicle
and must in no way obscure the vehicle registration.**

Article 4 Insurance

In accordance with the prescriptions of decrees 2006.554 of 16/05/2006, and its application decrees of 07/08/2006 and 27/10/2006, a policy will be taken out to guarantee (in the event of accident, fire or explosion occurring during the events) the pecuniary consequences of the civil liability which may be incumbent on the organisers and the participants, due to bodily injury or material damage caused to the spectators, to third parties or to the participants themselves. This policy also guarantees civil liability vis-à-vis the people in charge of the security service or participants in the organisation and control of the event.

It is up to the participants to check with their insurers that their various insurance contracts remain valid for the duration of the rally. If this is not the case, it is their responsibility to take all measures to cover the driver and the navigator against the risks of the rally.

Section 5 Advertising

The organizers reserve the right to make the agreements they deem useful with the advertising brands of their choice and to affix this advertising on the plates bearing the numbers of the participants or on the cars. Any other publicity, than that decided by the organisers, is strictly prohibited (unless agreed by the organisers).

Article 6 Withdrawal of records

Participants will report to the event reception, in order to collect the necessary documents (programme, detailed itinerary, rally plate), as desired.

FRIDAY at 2 p.m.,

SATURDAY from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.

SUNDAY from 8 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.

Article 7 Procedure

The event will take place in the tradition of courtesy and friendliness which are the rule among classic car enthusiasts.

THE TOURISTIC RALLY

The touristic rally will include a route that will mainly be on secondary roads in our region.

The start will be given at 9:00 am on Saturday. The participants in the rally do it under their sole responsibility, being a touristic rally, without any sporting aspect.

PRESENTATIONS / DEMONSTRATIONS

Only cars registered for the event before June 10 will be able to take part in the Sunday demonstrations. The demonstrations will take place in series of 30 vehicles. Participants will present themselves in the pre-grid a quarter of an hour before the start of their series. Out of respect for the public and the sponsors, unless the organisation agrees, the participants agree to stay during the entire Sunday event.

Registration of cars for the Sunday demonstrations only, is limited to pre-war vehicles, or by selection of the organisation.

Article 8 Commitments:

No commitment or registration will be taken by telephone.

Only the registration document available on <https://www.grandprixdetours.com> , received by the organisation will be registered. Your participation in the event will only be taken into account once the payment has been received, a confirmation of entry will then be sent to you. All requests for participation must be sent to:

For the Saturday rally, as soon as the maximum number of participants is reached, entries will be closed, according to the reception capacities of the various places visited. The organisers reserve the right to select entries, giving priority to pre-war vehicles and vehicles prior to 1960 and refusing any vehicle that does not correspond to the spirit of the event.

Article 9 Payment:

=> **in cash:** for foreigners who so wish, sending a deposit cheque in the currency of the country returned against cash on the day of the event.

Article 10 Cancellation conditions:

Any cancellation by the participant must be notified in writing (post or email) before June 10 in order to obtain a refund of the sums paid. In case of cancellation after this date, no refund will be made. All cases not provided for in these rules will be decided by the organising committee, comprising the managers of the Association du Grand Prix de Tours.
